- interdisciplinary study program
- offered in cooperation of 2 universities

Goals of the Study Program

- Impart and promote knowledge and acquirements for professional performance and coordination of evaluations.
- Impart core competencies, that prepare for internal organisation quality management and organisation development tasks.



Target Groups of the Study Program

- Program includes the entire spectrum of the evaluation field players.
- Open to all interested parties, that want to acquire additional qualifications for scientific, respectively professional operations in this research field – especially graduates of social science courses, but also graduates of other disciplines with a relation to the contents of the study program.



Duration of study: 4 semester part-time study including 10 weeks internship

The program follows a modular course structure (compatible with ECTS) and is divided in 2 phases:

1. phase: fundamentals of evaluation

2. phase: consolidation on basis of an optional subject:

- ✓ Evaluation of *Development Cooperation*
- ✓ Evaluation of *Social Services*
- ✓ Evaluation in the *Educational Area*
- ✓ Evaluation of *Economic Policy*
- ✓ Evaluation of *Sport-Organisations and Health-Suppliers*

2. Organisational Knowledge
3. Evaluation Practice
4. Data Collection and Analysis Methods in the Context of Evaluation
5. Key Qualifications
6. Subject and Field Expertise (in the chosen optional subject)
7. Internship/Practical Training
8. Master's Thesis



Application Requirements

- application requirement: university degree
- the program admits max. 25 students a year
- if the number of applicants exceeds 25 a prerequisite for admission becomes effective
 - selection criteria are:
 - the previous study performances
 - the personal qualification regarding evaluation and/or the optional subject
 - sound knowledge in social research



- Graduation: “Master of Evaluation”
- Tuition Fees: 1.000 €/semester
- Begin of Study: each winter semester
- Application Deadline: 15th July of each year
